- **1.** She considers a field and buys it and plants a vineyard with the fruit of her hands.
- **a.** She may be using money from her textile business to purchase this field. You can get a lot of things from growing a vineyard as well as selling the produce of it.

C. She is Prepared (Pro.31:21-22) for winter.

- **1.** She and her household are clothed in scarlet. Her clothing is silk and purple and she makes herself coverings of tapestry.
 - a. Scarlet dye, and possibly purple, come from the crimson or scarlet worm found in Israel.
 - b. Psalm 22. Jesus called himself a worm. The life cycle of the crimson/scarlet worm paints an amazing picture of what Jesus Christ did for us on the cross! Watch the video linked below.
 - c. Purple is a color of royalty and as believers in Jesus Christ we are God's children. Remember in Revelation we are also made kings and priests unto God.
 - d. See how Israel, still rejecting their Messiah, is using the scarlet worm to make a dye for temple fabric.
- 2. Tapestry is known to be threads that weave a picture as part of the material. Corrie Ten Boom's analogy about how our lives as Christians can seem a mess when we face all kinds of trouble and we don't understand what we are going through. However we see only one side. When the tapestry God is making with our lives is finished we see he was always at work with a plan and purpose and we finally see the beautiful finished product.
